

2025 Terms of Reference for the Harbour Advocacy Committee (HAC) of the Board of Directors

Common terms of reference applicable to all committees:

- Committee members are subject to approval by the Board.
- Committees are assigned Strategic Priorities by the Board.
- Committees **must report progress** to the Board when milestones reached, the Board requests, or at least annually.
- Committees are to produce brief **action plans or** elaborated terms of reference, as appropriate, for **information** to the Board and to **guide** Committee work.
- Committees may propose budgets for Board approval, or seek approval for each expenditure.
- The Board may refer additional issues or tasks to Committees throughout the year.

Elaborated Terms of Reference for the HAC:

- Members of the VEHS Board are ex officio members of the HAC, but are not obliged to participate.
- A Chair shall be selected from the non-Board members of the Committee; and a Vice-chair from amongst all members, who will serve as chair in the Chair's absence and otherwise assist the Chair.
- The chair is responsible for calling meetings inclusively to accommodate a majority of the membership and serving as meeting chair to support operation of the HAC as per the Terms of Reference.
- HAC is to be consensus-seeking (evidenced by lack of express objection as noted by the meeting chair), but if disagreement arises warranting formal resolution, decisions can be made at a dulycalled meeting by a double-majority vote of
 - i) all committee members and
 - ii) the Board ex officio members, at least two of whom must be present at the meeting.
- HAC may delegate actions and authorize expenditures from the HAC budget to members, who shall report back to the HAC.
- Unlike other Committees, external communication of new Committee/VEHS positions is not subject to prior Board approval.
